Foreign drama

This month we have a foreign drama with a major film by Robert Bresson. "Un condamné à mort s'est échappé" ("A Man Escaped") was released in 1956 and is regarded as one of Bresson's best films and a classic example of minimalism. With meagre resources he manages to create a great sense of suspense. It is also an example of the French coming to terms with the War: the reality of a crushing defeat in 1940 and widespread anti-semitism and collaboration was replaced by the myth of heroic French resistance.
