British Drama

Graham Greene is best known as a novelist but he also wrote a number of plays, most of which are now rarely performed. However, his skill as a playwright was also on display in his role as a writer of film scripts. "The Third Man" is one of the best known, often appearing high up in lists of the best ever films.

Local History / foreign Drama

"Une Parisienne" is a modern reworking of a Feydau farce, starring Charles Boyer and Brigitte Bardot. It is light and saucy. It's also a good illustration of the French fascination for the Royal Family.
